(All fees are subject to waiver by the Board during annual review.)

CPA Examination

- Board Administrative Fee for **Initial** Application **\$150**
(Nonrefundable for all first-time applications: 1-4 sections)
- Board Administrative Fee for **Re-examination** Application
(Nonrefundable)
 - 4 sections — **\$135**
 - 3 sections — **\$115**
 - 2 sections — **\$95**
 - 1 section — **\$75**
- Transfer of credits (to/from another State Board) **\$50**

Note: The Board also collects CPA Examination fees on behalf of AICPA, NASBA, and Prometric (Sylvan). These are separate fees set by those organizations. Current amounts are shown on the examination application.
